Student's Consent to Release of Education Records Disclosure to Parent Form

The purpose of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 is to protect the privacy of individual students by placing restrictions on the disclosure of information contained in a student's university record(s). At the university level, parents have no inherent rights to inspect your education records. However, education records can be released by Arkansas Tech University to your parents with your written consent, or by submission of evidence that parents have declared you as a dependent on their most recent Federal Income Tax return (according to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, §152).
