Business Technology

- Change name of HIT 1203 from Computers in Healthcare to Information Systems in Healthcare
- Require HIT 2233 Healthcare Management in the TC
- Create and require HIT 2343 Advanced (ICD-10 CM) Coding in the AAS
- Change name of HIT 2233 from Healthcare Statistics to Healthcare Analytics

Effective with the Fall 2018 semester in the HIT AAS degree:

- Combine HIT 1103 Health Data Content and Structure and HIT 2213 Healthcare Delivery Systems. Keep HIT 1103 Health Data Content and Structure as course number and title and rewrite course description
- Delete HIT 2213 Healthcare Delivery Systems from AAS requirements
- Change name of HIT 1203 from Computers in Healthcare to Information Systems in Healthcare
- Create and require HIT 2343 Advanced (ICD-10 CM) Coding in the AAS
- Change name of HIT 2233 from Healthcare Statistics to Healthcare Analytics

Effective with the Fall 2018 semester in the Health Information Technology TC and AAS:

- Require a grade of “C” or better in all HIT courses

Health Sciences

Effective with the Fall 2018 semester in the Health Sciences courses:

- Require a grade of “C” or better in HSCI 1113 Medical Terminology, HSCI 1123 Human Anatomical Structures I, and HSCI 1243 Human Anatomical Structures II.

Paramedic/Emergency Medical Services

Effective with the Fall 2018 semester in the Paramedic/EMS AAS degree and Certificate of Proficiency:

- Require a grade of “C” or better in all EMTP courses

Practical Nursing

Effective with Summer 2018 semester, require HSCI 1243 Human Anatomical Structures II to be taken before being accepted into the technical phase of the program.
