A READING OF THE THEORY OF LIFE CONTINGENCY MODELS: A PREPARATION FOR EXAM MLC/3L

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RESTATEMENT OF CREATIVE WORK

The purpose of the project is to author a book that discusses life contingency models. These models are basically studied by insurance companies to determine the risk associated with an applicant and based on such a risk a premium is determined.

The manuscript will be used by professionals and students to prepare for the actuarial exam MLC/3L of the Society of Actuaries and the Casualty Actuarial Society. The manuscript can also be used by educators in the field of actuarial mathematics and Finance.

BRIEF REVIEW OF PROCEDURE USED

The manuscript has been written based on several reference books in the field together with a list of MLC previous exams provided by the Society of Actuaries.

SUMMARY OF CREATIVE WORK
