SSS Scholars can take advantage of free program services available to program participants. For example, academic advice, career/major guidance, financial aid troubleshooting and so much more!

Eligibility is based on federally defined criteria where at least one of the following must be met:

- First Generation College Student (neither parent has a Bachelor's Degree)
- ➤ Limited Income (Income eligible per Federal Guidelines)
- ► Have a documented learning or physical disability

An eligible student must need academic support and be either a US Citizen or Permanent Resident who has not yet earned a bachelor's degree, but is committed to using SSS resources and graduating from ATU!

WHEN SHOULD I APPLY?

Immediately! Applications are accepted throughout the year, but program size is limited, so do not delay submitting your application.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Complete the attached application and submit to SSS by one of the following methods:

After submitting your application, you will be contacted by the SSS Office to schedule a meeting to discuss your application and academic needs. You will receive an email notification on whether or not you have been selected for the program.
