II. Updates

- **Leadership 2003 Proposal (Jeremy Schwehm)**
 - Jeremy Schwehm from Professional Studies visited to talk about the addition of Leadership 2003: Ethics In Leadership to the General Education catalog
 - This proposal was sent under the possible changing guidelines but was revised to meet the current guidelines
 - Course would provide a valuable addition by:
 1. Giving students a focus on self-development, self-reflection
 2. Is seen by employers as a valuable course addition
 - Was a question from Greg Michna about why this would fall under social sciences instead of Fine Arts and Humanities, were also similar questions from Josh Lockyer, and David Ward along those same lines
 - Jeremy Schwehm said that he did not have a preference between Social Sciences or Fine Arts and Humanities and was agreeable to have the class meet the Fine Arts and Humanities requirement as opposed to Social Sciences
 - Support for this move also came from Cheryl Chaney and Autumn Stoll
 - Committee then approved the adding of Leadership 2003 to the General Education curriculum based on it moving to Fine Arts and Humanities
