



Procedure for obtaining ATU College Credit for high school PLTW courses

NOTE: Only two PLTW courses are eligible to receive college credit in Arkansas Tech University's Mechanical and Electrical Engineering programs:

- Introduction to Engineering Design = 2 credits - for Engineering Graphics (MCEG 1002)
 - Principles of Engineering (POE) = 2 credits – for Introduction to Engineering (MCEG 1012 or ELEG 1012)
1. Student completes the PLTW course at a certified PLTW high school
 2. Student earns a grade of at least B in the PLTW course
 3. Student takes the PLTW course college credit exam at the high school and earns a grade of at least 70/100.
 4. Student fills out ATU/PLTW course form and sends to the ATU PLTW Affiliate Director (in this case Wayne Helmer)
 5. Student will provide ATU Registrar's office and ATU PLTW Affiliate Director with an official high School transcript that shows he/she passed the PLTW course with the necessary grade.
 6. The ATU PLTW Affiliate Director will sign off on the ATU PLTW form and send it to the ATU Registrar.
 7. After the student registers at ATU and finishes the first semester that student will have the ATU (PLTW) course listed on his/her transcript.
