Applications

- ❖ Free Applications for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) are available at local high schools, community colleges, or the Tech Financial Aid Office. This application is also available online at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>. **Processing dates: January 01, 2009 through April 15, 2010.**
- ❖ All aid applications will be processed in a timely manner once all requested information has been received and reviewed.
- ❖ Institutional scholarship applications are available from the Tech Office of Admissions.

Academic Eligibility

Completing the Federal and institutional applications will determine your eligibility. However, you need to establish and maintain academic eligibility using both the institutional and financial aid policies which are explained in the University catalog. Financial aid policies are also available in the Financial Aid Office and are subject to change.

Deadlines

- ❖ Federal Aid: **Priority April 15, 2009** *Note:* Students who apply early will receive the most desirable aid. Therefore, early application is recommended.
- ❖ Workforce Improvement Grant (WIG): July 15, 2009 or until funds are depleted.
- ❖ Tech privately funded (endowed) scholarships: March 15, 2009, unless otherwise listed in the University catalog.

Receipt of Funds

- ❖ In order to receive awarded funds, you **MUST** return all forms and answer all correspondence sent to you regarding student financial aid.
- ❖ All disbursements (including refund checks) are made through the Student Accounts Office.
- ❖ All awards are based on the student being enrolled full time. Less than full-time enrollment will result in the reduction of some or all awarded financial aid.
- ❖ **FEDERAL FUNDS MAY NOT BE IMMEDIATELY AVAILABLE.** Therefore, you should have personal funds of approximately \$500 per semester for books and other miscellaneous purchases.
