

# Student Success Center Tutor

## SSC Tutor Position Description

This position is a semester or academic year assignment, approximately 12-20 hours per week, reporting directly to the Student Success Coordinator.

## Qualifications & Requirements

- Tutors must have and maintain a cumulative and semester GPA of 3.0 or higher and must have earned a “B” or higher in class(es) to be tutored.
- Be currently enrolled as a student at ATU- Ozark Campus in good academic standing.
- Must be 18 years or older.
- Be available to workdays Monday – Thursday, in person, morning, afternoon, or both.
- Be available to work 8-15 hours per week.
- Participate in tutor training and monthly ongoing training/meetings with the Student Success Coordinator.
- Possess strong people, helping, and oral communication skills.

## Preferred Qualifications

- Tutors have and maintain a cumulative and semester GPA of 3.5 or higher, and have earned an “A” in class(es) to be tutored.
- ATU student with 12 or more credit hours completed.
- Experience in tutoring (can be informal; helping friends, siblings, or classmates with homework).

## General Responsibilities

A Tutor is a trained peer support and educator for the ATU-Ozark Campus. The main scope of a Tutor is to provide tutoring in the tutor’s area of expertise or the subject(s) that a Tutor is hired for. Additionally, a Tutor may provide general guidance and advice in areas of studying, note taking, test taking, student success strategies and campus resources. Tutors will foster a welcoming and inclusive learning environment and provide students with academic assistance and support that promotes independent learning and skills development. Other tasks and duties as assigned.
