MINUTES: The minutes from the May 3, 2017 Senate meeting were distributed. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Senator Clifton, seconded by Senator Spicer, and all approved, motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

- **Report from President's Communication Committee:** President Rudolph provided a summary from the President's Communication Committee meeting on the following topics:
 - Applications are being accepted for Leadership Franklin County. ATU Ozark send two employees.
 - Technology upgrades are currently taking place.
 - Reminder of Year-End deadlines.
 - Budget concerns were announced, and the University as a whole was reminded that to increase revenue, students must increase.
 - \circ Dr. Underwood retired as of June 1st.
 - New HR Director will begin employment June 1st.
 - Classified employee evaluations must be completed in a timely manner and sent to the appropriate channels for bonuses to be processed.
- **Report from Russellville Staff Senate:** Secretary Thomas did not provide a report from Russellville Staff Senate as their Staff Senate meeting had not occurred.
- Welcome New Senators: Julie Schmalz and Mike Bogue were elected as the new senators and will serve a three year term beginning July 1, 2017. The new members were welcomed and invited to stay for the remainder of the meeting.

- **By-laws review:** Senator Spicer reviewed the by-laws and the Constitution of the ATU Ozark Staff Senate.
- **Staff Potlucks:** The issue of regularly scheduled staff potlucks was brought back before the Senate by Senator Spicer. Senator Spicer was contacted by staff members who would like to see more regular scheduled potlucks taking place. Senator Harden suggested having a potluck and meeting quarterly on Friday mornings. The goal would be for all staff members to attend. The meeting would be able to bring staff members important information while enjoying each other's company at a potluck. President Rudolph agreed to talk to Chancellor Sikes to receive his input on the suggested potluck times and availability of all staff members attending.
- Update on Staff Excellence Award Criteria Changes- Senate members will bring ideas for a new selection and scoring process to the July meeting and once the ideas have been collaborated, the ideas will be given to Chancellor Sikes for review.

Senator Clifton believes more specific training for departments would be valuable to staff members. Members were asked to bring ideas for professional development as possible to the Senate.
