Dr. Patrick Hagge

Dr. Patrick Hagge is a tenured associate professor in the Department of History and Political Science. He received his M.S. and Ph.D. in Geography from the Pennsylvania State University.

While in academics for nearly a decade, Dr. Hagge was previously employed at Oak Ridge Laboratory as a GIS Analyst. He has taught numerous courses in Regional, Physical, and Human Geography and has been an important part of the department's advising team. Dr. Hagge has published in several peer-reviewed journals, written a large number of book reviews, and presented frequently at the Association of American Geographers. Further, he has also been involved in Computer and GIS Database creation. His exemplary service record broadly reflects his commitment to teaching and, more generally to the profession. He is a member of the Center for Teaching and Learning Advisory Board, a Faculty Advisor for the Anthropology Club, a cohort member of Leadership Tech, a member of the Faculty Mentor program and the General Education Committee, a member of the Campus Master Plan User Group, and an integral part of the eTech Advisory Committee.

Dr. Rogers is a tenured professor of Political Science in the Department of History and Political Science. He has been at Arkansas Tech University for thirteen years. He received his Ph.D from the University of Albany, State University of New York in 2005. He has numerous publications to his credit, as well as having been editor of a book collection and a special issue of *Midsouth Political Science Review*, in which he also serves as a member of the editorial board. Dr. Rogers has been a reviewer for the *Journal of Political Science Education* and *Polity*. He has taught extensively in American Politics, Political Theory, and Research Design. His service record attests to his institutional and professional commitment to excellence. He is the Vice President and Executive Board member of the American Political Science Association and is a long-serving officer of the Arkansas Political Science Association. Dr. Rogers has served on numerous committees, including the Arts and Humanities Dean's Search Committee, the University Athletic Director Search Committee, a Board Member of the Interdisciplinary Research Series, the Honor Code Committee, and the Campus Space and Utilization Committee. He was a member of the Faculty Senate for six years (2012-2020), serving on several subcommittees and chairing two subcommittees. He was a member of the Strategic Planning Committee, the Advisory Council for the ATU Center for Excellence in Teaching and Learning, the University Student Affairs Committee, and the University Athletic Committee.

Ms. Holly Ruth Gale has been a member of the Music Department for over twenty-five years and is well known for her creative productivity. She received her MM in Vocal Performance from the University of Central Arkansas and her BA in Music from Arkansas Tech University. Her stellar career has included familiar musical productions at the national level, such as *My Fair Lady*, *Carousel*, *Oklahoma!*, *Fiddler on the Roof*, and *A Christmas Carol*. Ms. Gale has acted in a number of plays, including *Steel Magnolias*, *The Buddy Holly Story*, and *Fox Fairway*. She has also done extensive work locally, including collaborations with the Arkansas River Valley Arts Center, the Center for the Arts in Russellville, and the First Methodist Church. Not only well known as a national soloist and ensemble performer, Ms. Gale has been a production consultant, an invited conference panelist and conference presenter, a director, a clinician, a choreographer, and a competition adjudicator. A credit to her institution and to the profession, beloved by her students, she has been an integral part of the musical history of Russellville and the State of Arkansas.
