<sup>5</sup>This program partners the Organizational Leadership undergraduate degree with the Master of Arts (MA) Organizational Leadership and Learning degree. A maximum of twelve (12) graduate level credit hours can be counted towards both the Bachelor of Arts degree in Organizational Leadership and the MA Organizational Leadership and Learning degree. Students can choose from any 5000-6000 level OL course offered in the MA Organizational Leadership and Learning degree, with the exception of <u>OL 6093</u> Organizational Development and Learning Capstone.

<sup>6</sup>This program partners the Organizational Leadership undergraduate degree with the Master of Science (MS) Emergency Management and Homeland Security degree. Students in this accelerated program can substitute up to twelve (12) hours of emergency management courses from the following: nine (9) hours from the graduate core: EMHS 6063 Principles of Emergency Management, EMHS 6093 Principles of Homeland Security, and EMHS 6103 Research Design and Methods, and three (3) electives from any approved EMHS course for up to 12 hours of 3000-4000 electives.
