Students in this accelerated program can substitute up to twelve (12) hours of emergency management courses from the following: nine (9) hours from the graduate core: [EMHS 6063](#) Principles of Emergency Management, [EMHS 6093](#) Principles of Homeland Security, and [EMHS 6103](#) Research Design and Methods, and three (3) electives from any approved EMHS course for up to 12 hours of 3000-4000 electives.
