- BDA 6203 Business Information Analysis can replace any School of Business Elective (3000-4000)
- MGMT 6203 Decision Modeling in Supply Chain Management can replace any MGMT Elective (3000-4000)
- MGMT 6103 Organizational Management and Leadership can replace any MGMT Elective (3000-4000)
- MKT 6113 Strategic Social Media Marketing can replace any School of Business Elective (3000-4000)
