- Candles
- Incense
- Fluid Lamps/Lanterns
- Walkie-Talkies
- Hoverboards
- Drones
- Skates (of any kind)
- Skateboards
- Scooters (of any kind)
- Bicycles/Unicycles
- Weapons (of any kind)
- Toys that look like weapons
- Handcuffs (or other restraint devices)
- Alcohol
