AGS is a FREE, four-week summer residential program for gifted and talented students who are upcoming high school seniors and residents of Arkansas. State funds provide tuition, room, board and instructional materials for each student who attends the program.

- Interested students must be nominated by their high school to attend. Contact your counselor, GT teacher, or AP teacher.
- Students apply in one of nine content areas: Choral Music, Development Engineering, Drama, English/Language Arts, Instrumental Music, Mathematics, Natural Science, Social Science, Visual Arts
- Application process includes at least two essays and must be submitted by Jan. 26, 2024.
- Arts areas also submit an audition video.
- Students must be willing to commit to the entire program. Students who would like to participate in other programs or activities that run concurrent to AGS should not apply.
