


# AGS Directory

The Arkansas Governor's School has gained a national reputation for excellence. It is a unique educational program for 400 gifted and talented high school students. The curriculum is neither an acceleration of high school nor is it an anticipation of college. Rather, it is designed to provide the tools for knowledge acquisition, critical analysis, generalization and creative model building, and the making of meaningful extrapolations essential for intelligent decision making in the 21st century. The fully residential program creates a Socratic environment for students, faculty, and staff, with a full schedule of speakers, films, discussions, and entertainment. Funding of the program by the State Legislature through the State Department of Education makes it possible for all students to attend without any personal expenditure.

Some 1984 highlights included speeches by Anthony Gregorc on "Styles of Learning", Sandra Kurjiaka on "The American Vision"; films "Night and Fog", "In the Heat of the Night", and "Sleeper"; ballet by Antonio Mesa, choral and instrumental music concerts, faculty and student coffeehouses, a talent show, and a student production of the play "To Kill a Mockingbird".
