This 1988 Arkansas Governor's School directory is dedicated to the faculty and staff who have touched so many lives with their enthusiasm, their idealism, and their commitment to enriching the students' intellectual and artistic mental view of the world.

The Arkansas Governor's School is a unique educational program designed to focus on the sharpening of intellectual skills, the nurturing of creativity, and the development of the personal and social consciousness essential for 21st Century problem solving. The summer residential program is designed to create an optimal learning environment for some of Arkansas' most gifted and talented students. Students attend two Area I classes daily and one on Saturday, as well as three Area II and three Area III classes each week. Many of the classroom discussions continue in less formal settings around the campus. There are many guest speakers; some are entertaining, some are controversial, but all are thought provoking for those who listen. There are also multiple film series, as well as several cultural and social events packed into the six week program. There are no grades or credits given, yet there are the very highest academic expectations. There is an unusual degree of academic freedom which is bound only by a sense of responsibility to be intellectually rigorous. The program is fully funded by the Arkansas State Legislature through the Arkansas Department of Education, and thus there is no cost to the 400 participants.

The Arkansas Governor's School experience is impossible to describe adequately. Each individual student is likely to have gained several new friends, new insights, new aspirations, and even new ways of thinking. Some of these will probably last a life-time and may, in fact, turn out to be "life changing" for the participant. It is the fond hope of all those who have labored to make the Arkansas Governor's School work that each student will have gained in intellectual skills and will have set higher standards of excellence in all life's endeavors as a result of this summer's experience.
