

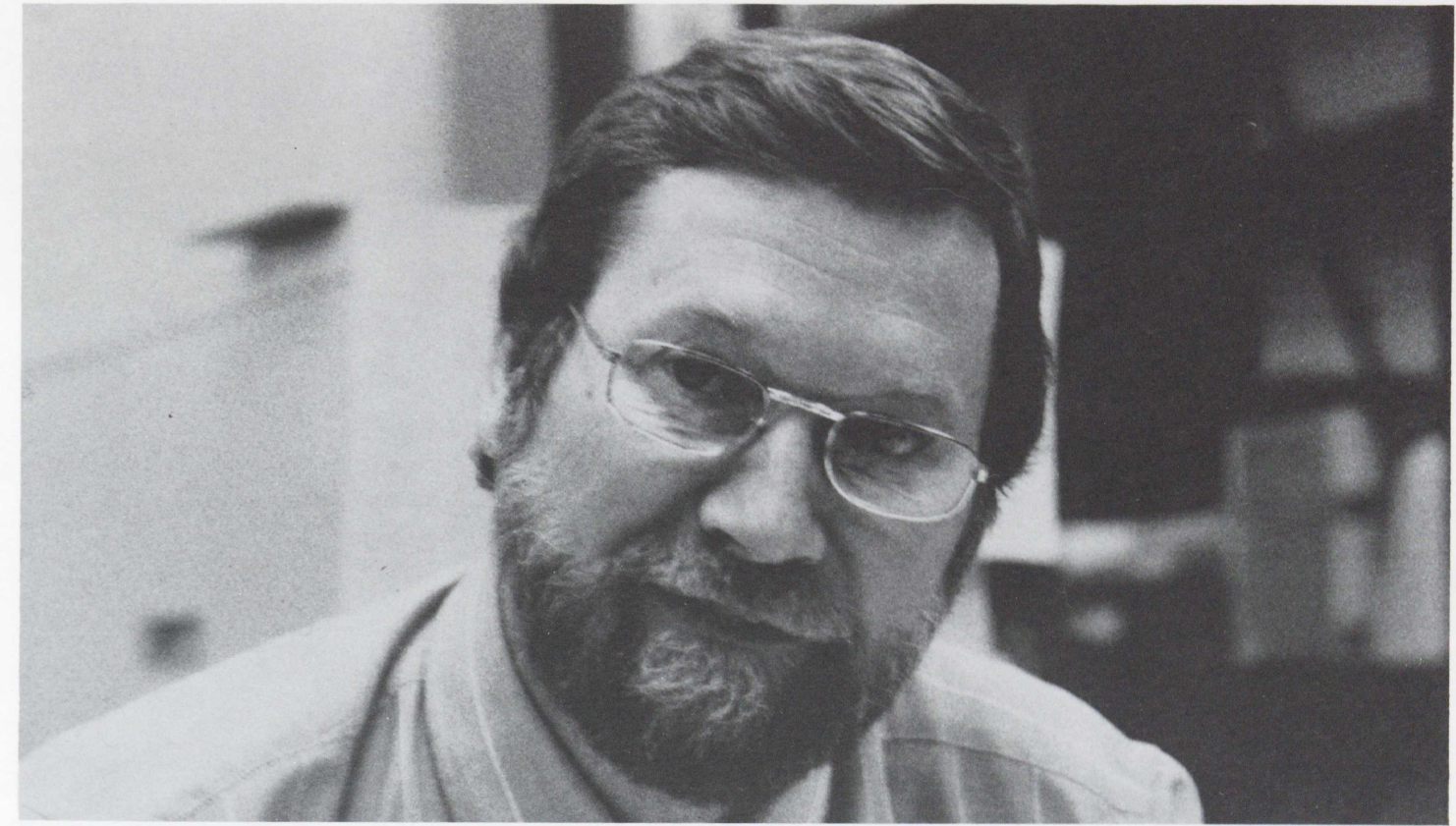

AREA I embraces instruction in the performing arts of choral music, drama, instrumental music, and visual arts and course work in the academic disciplines of English/language arts, mathematics, natural science, and social science. Emphasis in Area I is placed on participatory learning experiences that prepare students to enter and understand the critical systems that undergird the various fields of study. To this end, the students examine new, challenging and often controversial theories, techniques, and works--all designed to encourage them to develop a critical stance based on careful scrutiny of ideas and developments within their area of interest. 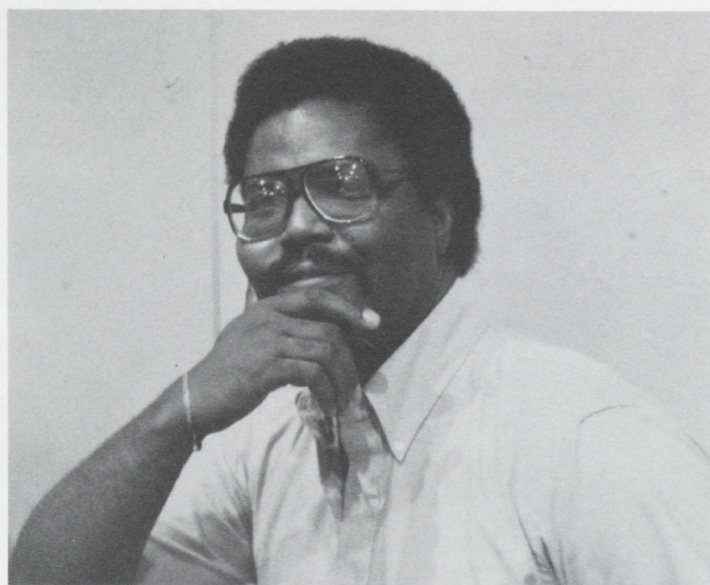
ARTIST-IN-RESIDENCE

AREA II encourages critical thinking and conceptual development by exploring the foundations of knowledge. Discussions, which often cut across disciplinary lines, tend to center around epistemological and normative issues raised by 20th Century theorists. The goal of these discussions is not so much to reach agreement as it is to progress to deeper levels of intellectual reflections.

AREA III students attend classes three times weekly. These classes are designed to foster the development of personal resources needed to meet the challenges the students confront as their knowledge expands and they encounter alternative worldviews. As part of an over-all integrated curriculum of AGS, Area III attempts to create an environment of trust, confidentiality, and community where students can explore the diversity of belief systems and ideas presented to them throughout the AGS experience. The goal is to provide students with insight into the nature of their abilities, the advantages these capabilities might provide, and the anxieties these aptitudes might generate, as well as make them aware of the societal responsibilities they have toward various communities to which they belong. In this way, students may be able to optimize their use of those abilities.
