The 1993 Arkansas Governor's School began amidst controversy brought on by the national circulation of a propaganda video on the AGS entitled "The Guiding Hand: The Clinton Influence of Arkansas Education". It was produced the preceding fall and designed to be used against Governor Bill Clinton's successful campaign for the United States Presidency. The video received national attention after it was mentioned on the Rush Limbaugh television show. According to a circular sent by the American Family Association of Arkansas entitled "GOVERNOR'S SCHOOL SINISTER AND DEVASTATING; STUDENTS BRAINWASHED FOR SIX WEEKS", the video exposes "one of the most sinister plots—to control the minds of the next generation—that you could imagine". The program thus began with a heightened sense of the significance and importance of the unique type of educational program offered by the state of Arkansas. Every effort was made to insure that the 1993 program was the best educational experience possible and to provide the maximum opportunity for personal, intellectual, and artistic growth for each student. All participants are urged to express their appreciation for both the funds provided by the State of Arkansas through the Arkansas Education Department and for the facilities provided by Hendrix College, which make the AGS program possible.

All 398 selected students registered and were welcomed by Senator Dale Bumpers on opening day. Squeezed into the short six weeks were classes galore, lots of featured speakers and films, many 3:15 speakers, a trip celebrating the fourth of July to the Conway Human Development Center (160 students volunteered to work with clients), a Red Cross blood drive, dances, dorm activities, games, and other recreation. (The faculty/staff steam bested the students in the traditional faculty/staff vs. students softball game.) Governor Jim Guy Tucker spoke about the significance of education and of the AGS program on Parents' Day. A major part of the uniqueness of the AGS residential program for Arkansas high school students is the emphasis on theory, tolerance for ideas, willingness to discuss significant current issues, and thoughtfulness about controversial topics that creates a truly remarkable campus atmosphere. The opportunity to listen, to question, and to discuss issues of importance to us created a sense of enthusiasm for putting forth an individual and collective effort to make the world a better place. There was an evident sense of joy in students, staff, and faculty as they were involved in these intellectual challenges. There was also the realization that all of us do indeed have some important, commonly shared basis of understanding and ideals. But-best of all--many, many new friendships were made and some of them will undoubted last a lifetime.

I hope each of you gained knowledge, experience, and a heightened sense of joy as a result of your six weeks involvement in the 1993 Arkansas Governor's School. May each of you retain a life-long enthusiasm for learning, living, and striving for your dreams and ideals.

To all who were participants, I wish you the best of luck and success in your future.

As part of an over-all integrated curriculum of AGS, Area III attempts to create an environment of trust, confidentiality, and community where students can explore the diversity of belief systems and ideas presented to them throughout the AGS experience. The goal is to provide students with insight into the nature of their abilities, the advantages these capabilities might provide, and the anxieties these aptitudes might generate, as well as make them aware of the societal responsibilities they have toward various communities to which they belong. In this way, students may be able to optimize their use of those abilities.
