

The Area II Curriculum is designed to enhance conceptual development. Students are encouraged to learn more about how knowledge is acquired (epistemology) and to understand the various ways of knowing in different disciplines. In striving to increase their ability to analyze diverse perspectives on current normative issues, students gain a new appreciation for the implications of those issues. Classroom discussion then leads students to progress toward deeper levels of intellectual reflection, which enhances their ability to become better thinkers.
