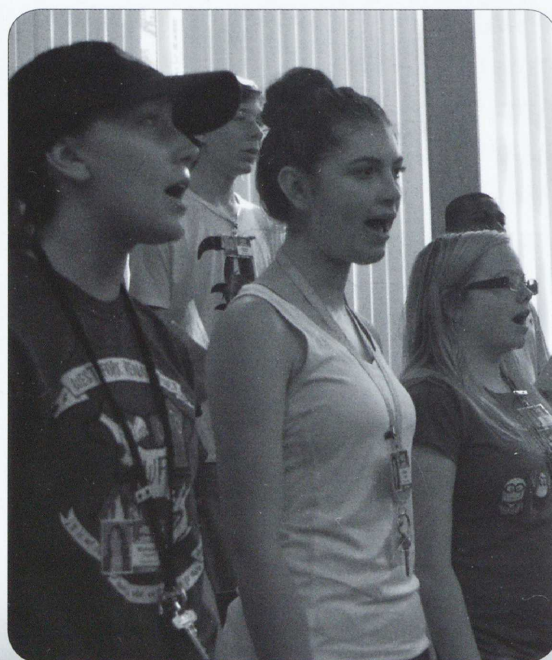
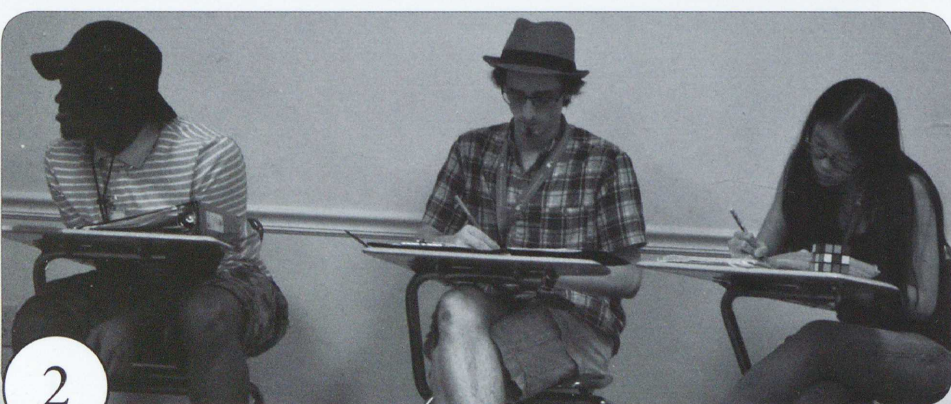
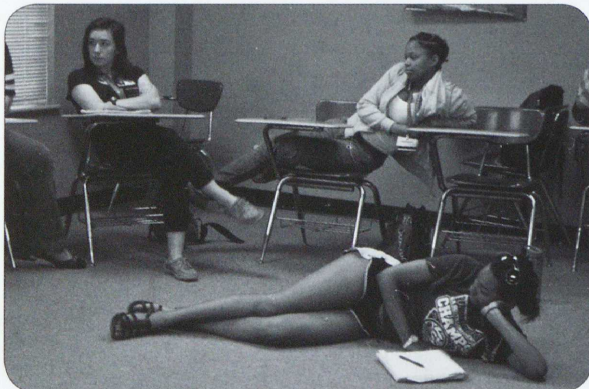
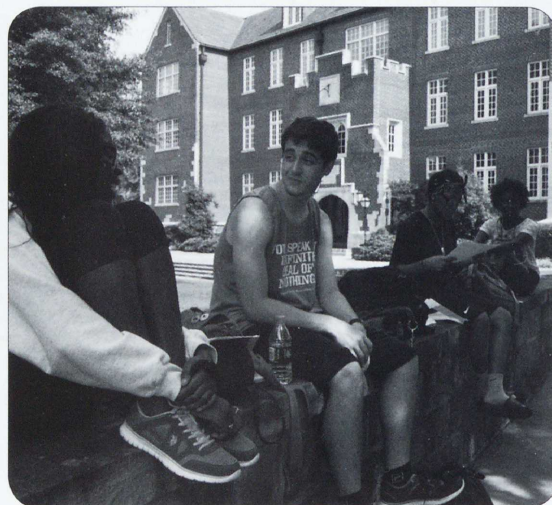




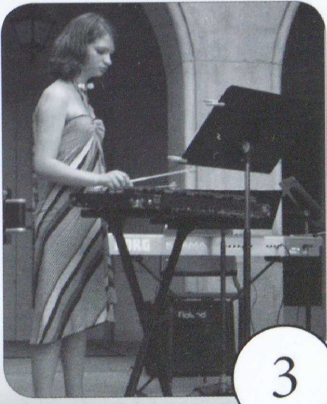
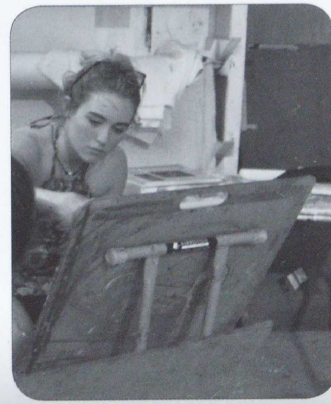
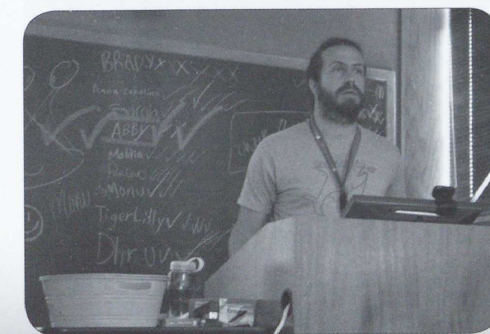
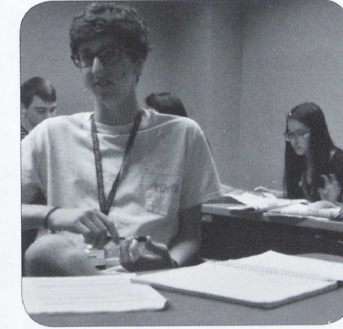
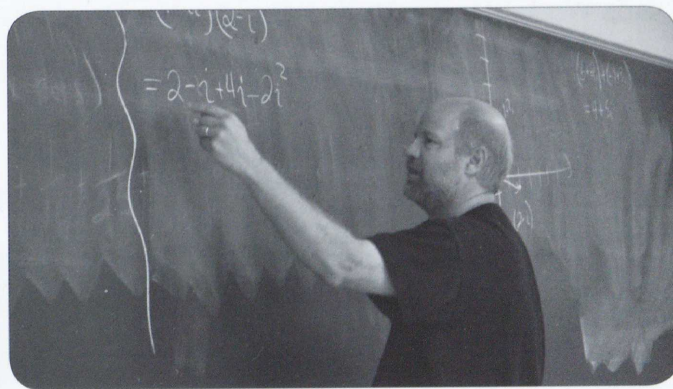
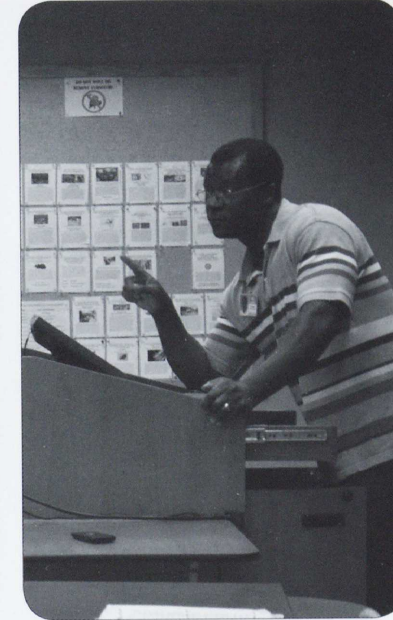
# AREA I

Within this framework, students explore curricular issues such as theories of intelligence, conflict and stress management, psychological and personal theory, goal setting, and community service.
