- For sole proprietor or partnership using a business name, file a Doing Business as (DBA) Certificate at the Johnson County Clerk's Office

- If your business is a LLC, C corporation, or S corporation, or you have employees, apply for your Employer Identification Number (EIN) with the IRS at <https://sa.www4.irs.gov/modiein/individual/index.jsp>
- Obtain a Business License from the City Clerk's Office
