Accreditation Decision: Continuing Accreditation with Conditions

Stipulation:

A Follow-Up Report requires the nursing program to demonstrate compliance with all Criteria in only the Standard(s) with which the program was found to be in non-compliance. The Follow-Up Report for the master's nursing program is to address **Standard 2 Faculty**.

Please note that ACEN policy stipulates that a nursing program must demonstrate compliance within a maximum of two years after being placed on continuing accreditation with conditions by the Board. If compliance is not evident at the end of the monitoring period, the program must be denied continuing accreditation and removed from the list of accredited programs, unless the program can make its case for continuing accreditation for good cause. Stipulation Time Frame: One Year

Follow-Up Report Due Date: February 15, 2026

Next Site Visit Cycle: Fall 2032
