Enclosed please find the 2013/2014 Monitoring Committee Report for your URE Program. I am pleased to inform you that CORE's Undergraduate Commission on Standards and Accreditation has reviewed your Annual Program Progress Report for the 2013/2014 academic year and found no reason to add additional conditions to assure continued compliance with the CORE Standards for Undergraduate Rehabilitation Education Programs. Subsequently, in official session on July 18, 2014, the Council on Rehabilitation Education approved continuation of your program's accreditation through the 2014/2015 academic year.

The annual monitoring process will occur in the same way for 2014/2015, with no response necessary until you receive the Annual Program Progress Report around February/March which will be due in the CORE office by **April 1, 2015.** A program's accreditation status shall automatically convert to "On Probation" accreditation status if the program has not satisfied conditions within the time period noted earlier in an accreditation evaluation and/or has not satisfied conditions within the time period noted in an Annual Program Progress Report (see *CORE Policies & Procedures manual*). Re-evaluation for a new term of Accreditation will occur in the last year of your current term.
