

Assessment Steps	Description	Thoughts about my program or department
Develop or review your program or department mission	 Understanding your mission will help in the next step. Goals and objectives should always be in line with the mission statement. These should be reviewed every year or two. 	
2. Develop goals and objectives for success	 Goals are broad and are SMART (specific, measurable, attainable, relevant, time-bound). Objectives are specific and drive toward meeting your goals. What do you want to achieve? What do you want students to achieve? These should be reviewed every year or two.

3. Design programs & services	 How will you achieve your goals and objectives? How are you implementing? What's your timeline? 	
4. Determine measures	How will you know you achieved them?

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5. Provide program/service	 Get to work reaching goals! This is the action phase of your plan. 	
6. Collect evidence	 Measure your outcomes. What results have you collected?

7. Analyze evidence	 What do the results suggest? Did you meet your objectives?

8. Interpret and share results	 What could have gone better? What should be changed for the next go-round to get the results you're wanting? Discuss with your colleagues.

9. Determine actions for improvement	 What's the plan for next time? What are you changing? Make and implement evidence-based decisions.
