 - National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE)
 - The Office of Assessment (UAA) is sponsoring the NSSE which opens for first-year and senior students March 8-May 11. These students will receive Blackboard notification and emails from NSSE beginning March 8 with a unique URL to their survey. We'll be able to see survey completion data about a week into the survey including if students are responding well to the Blackboard link or if they use the email link instead.
