However, the survey administered to students only asked them to share one thing that they learned from the Tech Talk. Although they did not share two things, their comments were accurate to what was presented to them during the Tech Talk.

At the flu clinic, 90% of 137 students were able to verbally identify at least one way to prevent spread of the flu (see attached document).

We will need assistance from the nursing department to ensure we have nursing students available to help us administer flu vaccines.
