#### **Tips for Tone - Embouchure**

**Posture**/Position

Eliminate Pressure on the reed

**Mouthpiece Pitch/TONE** 

**C**Equipment

Long Tones (but not too long)

### **32800** Tips for Tongue - Articulation

E SCHATBEWAARDER, ER SCHATZMEISTER.

ONDER

DE GOUVERNEUR, DER GOUVERNEUR, **Tip of the Tongue** 

Legato vs Staccato

**V**Air pressure

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Work it! The tongue is a muscle

**W**Remove horn

#### **Tips for Technique – Fingers**

**Fingers curved and close** SLOW **Follow through Metronome** Variety of strategies (next) **Plan out fingerings Always use correct dynamics**, articulation

### Tips for Technique – Strategies

LWAYS use metronome, Always Entire passage, slow to fast (how slow can you go?) Sequencing smaller sections Groupings on the move 1234, 2345,3456 "Butter" Add-a-note (fw, bw) boomerang Click then play Record yourself and listen back

#### REMEMBER


Establish a routine, and don't ignore the "boring stuff" (LT, MP, etc)
Limits: don't overuse each technique, use them all
Limits: don't overplay each pattern, rotate them all
No "rage practicing," take breaks instead or come see me!

**V** Reed – Cane vs Synthetic **V**Reed Strength Use Lig – what's that thing called again? Mouthpiece – the holy grail **Horn** – does it matter? Veck Strap – do you like chronic back pain? **W** Mass – does it matter? Cleaning and care –
