No. The national organization is on a hiatus while conducting a strategic review. Arkansas Tech University will continue to use previously defined parameters to recognize our student leaders with the Who's Who at Arkansas Tech University award.

How can I access the application?

Who's Who applications are available on theLink at thelink.atu.edu. To locate the application, please go to the Campus Life page and click on the Forms tab.

I have questions regarding eligibility or criteria for Who's Who?

Students are selected for Who's Who based upon:

- Academic achievement
- Service to the community while enrolled at Tech
- Leadership and involvement in co-curricular activities
- Potential for continued success

Undergraduate students eligible to apply are those who:

- Are full-time students (must be currently enrolled in at least 12 hours)
- Have completed at least 90 hours by the end of the fall in which the student is applying.
- Have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.75
- Have not previously received this honor

Graduate students eligible to apply are those who:

- Are full-time students (graduate assistants - 6 hours | all other graduate students - 9 hours)
- Have completed at least 12 graduate hours by the end of the fall in which the student is applying.
- Have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.25
- Have not previously received this honor

Are there any guidelines for the essay?

Please upload the essay in a PDF or WORD format in the Who's Who application on theLink. All essays submitted for consideration must be a minimum of 500 words, approximately 1.5 pages (12 point font, Times New Roman, double-spaced). Please, no submissions over 550 words.

When will students be notified if selected?

Notification will be sent via mail on December 1, annually.

*Note: Past involvement will be sent for approval prior to appearing on the Involvement Record.

It is recommended to adjust dates on your Involvement Record so that the dates accurately display your time in each item listed.

Other experiences on/off campus can be added by clicking on your name toggle at the top right of the screen, and then click on "Experiences."

Please consider including:

Awards: On-campus or off-campus recognition of excellence in an area or specific topic.

Certifications: Any classes or instruction in which a student gained a new skill or area of competency.

Community Service: Service work in the community or another community such as Alternative Spring Break, mission trips, and/or on-going volunteering with specific agencies.

Internships: Any period of time during which a student acquires experience in an occupation or profession.

Music and Theater: Any experience in which a student participates in an activity that showcases music and theater, such as marching band, ensembles, singing, plays, etc.

National, Regional, State, or Community Organization Involvement:

Involvement in an organization that is not a Registered Student Organization at Arkansas Tech University.

Sports: Any experience in which a student participates in athletic activity such as collegiate athletics or intramural sports.

Student Employment: On-campus jobs for which a student is paid (by fellowship or hourly).

Student Media: Participation in on-campus media such as newspaper, radio, or television.

When you have finished inputting all of your memberships and experiences, go back to the Involvement Record and click "Create PDF."

Save the document and upload to the Who's Who application on theLink.
