Study Abroad Makes You More Employable



In The Data

61% OF EMPLOYERS...

considered international experience important

23% LESS LIKELY TO BE UNEMPLOYED...

five years after graduation, if participated in study abroad

64% OF EMPLOYERS...

were more likely to give graduates with international experiences increased professional responsibilities

Factors Affecting Employability

DOMAIN KNOWLEDGE

knowledge gained in subject area

WORK EXPERIENCE

internships, apprenticeships, service learning, and volunteering

COGNITIVE/SOCIAL/ PERSONAL SKILLS

problem-solving, decision-making, group work, adaptability, flexibility

CROSS-CULTURAL COMPETENCE

understand differences among and ability to adapt to other cultures
