FIRE

Evacuate

- > Call 911 to report the fire
- > Notify and assist people in the immediate area
- > Close all doors behind you
- Do not re-enter until authorized by emergency personnel
- > Never assume an alarm is false
- > Do not use elevators
- If unable to exit, go to nearest exit stairwell or safe area and call 911
- Use fire extinguisher if fire is small, contained and room is not filled with smoke
- Move 500 feet away from building once evacuated

WEATHER

Shelter-in-Place

- > Seek shelter indoors
- Check atu.edu/emergency for shelter-in-place procedures at Arkansas Tech
- If a Tornado Warning is issued, seek shelter indoors in an interior room away from windows, and on the lowest floor possible
- Do NOT leave buildings if you are indoors

ACTIVE SHOOTER

Avoid, Deny, Defend

If an active shooter or violent person is in your vicinity, please attempt to take the following steps:

- AVOID: If possible, exit the building immediately and call dial 911.
- DENY: If you cannot exit, clear the hallway quickly, remain behind closed doors in a locked or barricaded room

if possible, and stay away from interior windows

 DEFEND: Do not attempt to confront or apprehend the shooter, unless it is a last resort
