








Actual Electrical Use in kWh by Month

ATU Energy Policy Recommendations

Individual Responsibility

 Eliminate wasted energy by turning things off when not in use, limiting the presence and use of personal appliances, limit working in buildings outside of normal working hours, keep doors and windows closed that separate conditioned spaces and non-conditioned spaces

Institutional Responsibilities

 Purchase Energy Star rated equipment, set all electronics to utilize energy saver mode and manage their operation in the most efficient manner, turn off all equipment and systems when outside of normal operating hours

HVAC Systems Operation

 Utilize standard temperature settings throughout the campus during normal operating hours, limit system operation outside of normal operating hours, and set systems to limit ventilation and humidity when outside of normal operating hours
