Arkansas artist Sammy Peters is set to kick off the 2014-15 Norman Art Gallery schedule August 18 with his show Internal Narrative. As a child in Arkansas during the fifties, Peters was encouraged in art by his father, owner of a sign painting business, and by his teacher at Little Rock's Central High School who introduced him to Abstract Expressionism. Peters studied painting at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock and the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville. Since then he has gained renown success through exhibitions in major art
