# **Housing: Frequently Asked Questions**

### **How do I Apply?**

From the <u>Residence Life</u> website, click on **Apply for Housing**. You will need your *OneTech username* and *password* to login. **You must first <u>Activate</u> your OneTech account**.

## What are the Residence Halls Like?

You will have the chance to live in any of the 13 residence halls. These are mainly coed halls with suite style bath, private bath, private community bath, or community bath options. A few of the residence halls are male only or female only. Caraway Hall is only available to members of our female sororities.

We also offer several <u>Living Learning Communities</u> in specific residence halls. These are rooms reserved for student with a shared academic focus/major. At this time, there are 4 LLCs on campus: Agriculture, Engineering, First Year Experience, and Hospitality.

Our University Commons and Vista Place apartments will become available to you when you have a 2.5 cumulative GPA and have earned 30 or more college credit hours. All halls and apartments are completely furnished and utilities are included. Other amenities include cable television, wired and wireless internet, and laundry services.

#### Which Hall is the Best?

This depends on your tastes and your needs. For more information about each individual residence hall, please see our list of <u>Residence Halls and Apartments</u>.

#### **How Much Does It Cost?**

The room charges depend on the residence hall and the type of room you choose. A private room will cost more than a shared double room. The exact prices for each residence hall can be found on the Student Accounts website under Room Charges – Per Semester.

# **Do I Have to Live on Campus?**

Single students **between the ages of 18 and 21**, and with **fewer than 60 earned credit hours** of college work, are required to live on campus in University owned housing facilities. Exemptions to the On-Campus Residency Requirement include: students living with immediate family (Mother, Father, Sister, or Brother) within 30 miles driving distance of the Russellville campus, married students, or students with dependent children.

Students who are 17 years of age at the time they move into the residence halls will be required to sign the Arkansas Tech University Waiver and Release of Liability for a Minor Living on Campus.

#### Do I Need a Meal Plan?

**Yes**. All students living on campus (except in the East Gate Apartments, University Commons Apartments, or Vista Place apartments) are required to have a meal plan.
