### **Important Information**

Team projects must be entered and presented by only *ONE* team member. Team projects *cannot be split into two entries*. The other team member may attend the symposium as an observer delegate.

The research paper submitted should be of an investigative type that includes collection of data and empirical evidence and conclusions. It should not consist of *ONLY* library research information.

All research papers must be submitted in electronic format using to [arkansas.jshs@gmail.com](mailto:arkansas.jshs@gmail.com) by **February 1, 2014**. A copy of the "Research Paper Submission Form" should be included with the submission of the paper (include it as a scanned picture in the file). An acknowledgement of receipt will be provided when the file is submitted. If you do not receive a confirmation message after your submission, please contact Dr. Kellner as soon as possible.

A panel of judges will review each paper and select papers to be presented at the Arkansas Junior Science & Humanities Symposium. Each student who is selected will be introduced at the recognition/awards banquet, and be asked to present their paper at the symposium. Students chosen to present their papers will not be allowed to enter the poster contest.

Each copy of the research paper must include a cover page that includes only the title of the paper (DO NOT PLACE ANY IDENTIFYING INFORMATION SUCH AS THE STUDENT'S NAME OR SCHOOL ON THIS COVER PAGE)

The top five delegates as determined by the Arkansas JSHS judges panel will be selected to attend the National Junior Science & Humanities Symposium sponsored by the United States Army, Navy, and Air Force. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place regional winners will be given the opportunity to present their papers at this national symposium. (All travel, lodging, and meals associated with traveling to the symposium will be provided by the National JSHS Office)

Finally, the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place presenters will receive college scholarships provided by the United State Armed Forces.
