Review the schedule, your session type, and your location early. Planning ahead reduces stress and helps you focus on your presentation instead of logistics.


POLISH YOUR MATERIALS

Check your slides or poster for clarity, readability, and flow. Practice explaining each section so you can confidently guide your audience through your work.



PRACTICE OUT LOUD

Run through your presentation several times. Saying it aloud helps you refine your timing, transitions, and delivery—and it builds confidence for the big day.



BE READY FOR QUESTIONS

Anticipate what people might ask about your research. Prepare short, clear responses that show your understanding and enthusiasm for the topic.





Introduce yourself to judges, faculty, and other presenters. A friendly conversation can lead to new ideas, mentorship, or future collaboration opportunities.

ENJOY THE MOMENT

You've worked hard to get here—celebrate it!
Presenting your research is an accomplishment in itself, so take a deep breath and have fun sharing what you've learned.
