

ATU Ozark Campus TEAS Test Information

TEAS Test Information:

- The TEAS test is a computerized test; scores will be immediately available.
- When testing during a Closed TEAS test, test results will be forwarded to the program office.
 - Test results for students that have applied to multiple programs will be made available to all programs applied for.
- There are four sections the TEAS test will cover:
 - Reading- 45 questions, 55 minutes to complete
 - Mathematics- 38 questions, 57 minutes to complete
 - Science- 50 questions, 60 minutes to complete
 - English & Language Usage- 37 questions, 37 minutes to complete

ATU-Ozark offers two types of TEAS tests:

- The Closed TEAS is offered in person on the ATU-Ozark campus to health program applicants only.
 - Given **after** the application deadline for each semester
 - Health Program Applicants will receive an email after the application deadline that includes Closed TEAS testing dates and times, as well as information on how to pay the testing fee.
 - Applicants may only test **once** during the dates of the Closed TEAS testing held on campus.
 - Applicants are not required to test during the Closed TEAS test dates if submitting results from an online TEAS or a TEAS test from another location.
- The Open TEAS tests are available for anyone to take.
 - Dates will be scheduled for each February, July, and September
 - Can be taken for practice purposes for those planning to apply for a health program
 - Can be taken by individuals that are not ATU-Ozark students
 - Dates will be announced and promoted through social media and other forms of marketing, but will not be sent only to health program applicants.

Important Information for Health Program Applicants:

- TEAS results from Open TEAS tests offered at ATU-Ozark will be accepted provided the test is less than a year old.
- TEAS results from testing at locations other than ATU-Ozark will be accepted provided:
 - the test is the same version (version 7)
 - the test is less than a year old
- TEAS results from online TEAS testing will be accepted provided:
 - the test is the same version (version 7)
 - the test is less than a year old
 - the test was completed using the ATI Remote Proctor-Nursing option through the ATI website
 - the Nursing TEAS option should always be chosen, even if the ATU-Ozark program you are applying to is not a nursing program.
- TEAS results from other testing locations and/or online TEAS testing must be turned in to the Allied Health secretary by the date of the last Closed TEAS test offered at the ATU-Ozark Campus for each application cycle.
- The highest of all eligible TEAS scores submitted by an applicant will be the score used to determine possible program placement.
