

Occupational Therapy Assistant Admission Requirements

Prior to admission, students must complete a platform of 28 hours with a minimum 2.5 GPA, which includes general education and medical courses. Students can be completing their final prerequisites at the time of application to the OTA program. Students must be eligible for admission to ATU- Ozark and meet entrance requirements for acceptance into the Occupational Therapy Assistant program.
