MA-C stands for Medication Assistant-Certified. A MA-C is a person who is certified by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing to administer certain medications in designated facilities.

### HOW TO BECOME A MA-C

- Be in good standing with CNA registry continuously for a minimum of one year
- Have one-year continuous experience as a CNA in the state of Arkansas
- Be currently employed at a designated facility
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Completed the Accuplacer literacy and reading comprehension screening process
- Successfully completed a MA-C course approved by ASBN-THIS WILL BE DONE AT ATU OZARK!
- Successfully passed a ASBN approved certification examination

### WHAT CAN A MA-C DO?

A MA-C may perform the delegated function of medication administration and related tasks under the supervision of a licensed nurse to no more than 40 patients during a shift.

The MA-C can administer medications via the following route:

Oral-buccal, sublingual	Intranasal
Topical	Eye, ear or nose drops
Vaginal	Rectal
Transdermal	Oral inhalers

A Designated Facility is an Arkansas State Board approved facility to include nursing home or a local correctional facility.
