ATU-Ozark campus students who have completed an ATU-Ozark campus Associate of General Studies, Associate of Applied Science or Technical Certificate degree program with a minimum 3.00 cumulative college GPA are eligible to apply for a Transitions Scholarship. These scholarships are competitively awarded and amounts vary. The priority scholarship application deadline for the fall term is April 1 and for the spring term is December 1. An early admission status is required to receive scholarship consideration. Students who receive Transitions Scholarships must enroll in and complete 15 or more Arkansas Tech hours with a 3.25 semester GPA to be eligible for renewal for five consecutive semesters or until the completion of an undergraduate degree, whichever comes first.

All scholarship recipients must be admitted to the university, enrolled in a minimum of 15 hours each semester and complete a minimum of 30 hours each year (fall/spring) with a cumulative of 3.0 GPA to be eligible for scholarship renewal, and have a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file before the scholarship will be authorized. Unless an exemption to the residency requirements is received from the Residence Life Office, all scholarship recipients must live on campus. Students receiving Transitions Scholarships must be U.S. citizens. To remain in compliance with Act 323 of 2009, the University reserves the right to cancel or modify any scholarship funded by the institution at any time. Transitions Scholarships are renewable for five consecutive semesters after the first or until the completion of an undergraduate degree, whichever comes first, provided the student maintains all scholarship requirements.
