PMs are expected to be a resource to their Mentees by, but not limited to, providing information about the campus/resources, sharing their experiences as a first-year student, meeting with Mentees (1:1 & as a group), answering general questions, and attending planned trainings, workshops, and events.

Qualifications:

- Have and maintain a 3.0 GPA and be in good academic standing throughout the academic year
- Commit to the position for a full academic year
- Must be enrolled for a minimum of 3 credits in both semester terms
- Actively participate in Peer Mentor Trainings, events, & SSC workshops throughout the academic year

Peer Mentor Responsibilities & Expectations:

- Serve as a positive role model and resource for up to 3 college freshman Mentees
- Meet with their group of mentees at least twice per month throughout the academic year
 One of those meetings will be held in the Student Success Center
- Conduct weekly check-ins with their Mentee(s).
- Participate in training
- Become familiar with the various resources available to students on campus
- Assist new students in making a healthy transition to college
- Complete Peer Mentee Review(s) at the end of each academic semester.
- Communicate and work with fellow Peer Mentors to uphold a positive and collaborative group dynamic.
- Communicate with the Student Success & Disability Services Coordinator any issues that arise with your student mentee.
