- Change the requirement from FAC 2202 Carpentry to FAC 2202 Carpentry or approved elective
- Change the requirement from FAC 2212 Plumbing to FAC 2212 Plumbing or approved elective
- Change the requirement from FAC 2203 Facilities Analysis and Troubleshooting to FAC 2203 Facilities Analysis and Troubleshooting or approved elective

Beginning with Summer I 2009 semester, in the curriculum requirements for the Associate of Applied Science for Air Conditioning and Refrigeration degree Facilities Management option:

- Change the requirement from FAC 2202 Carpentry to FAC 2202 Carpentry or approved elective
- Change the requirement from FAC 2212 Plumbing to FAC 2212 Plumbing or approved elective
- Change the requirement from FAC 2203 Facilities Analysis and Troubleshooting to FAC 2203 Facilities Analysis and Troubleshooting or approved elective
- Change the requirement from FAC 2222 Grounds Maintenance to FAC 2222 Grounds Maintenance or approved elective

Automotive Service Technology

Beginning with Summer I 2009 semester, in the curriculum offerings in Automotive Service Technology:

• Create AST ###1-6 Special Topics with semester credit hours varying from 1 to 6 hours of credit. The course may be taken for credit two times.

Business Technology

Beginning with Summer I 2009, in the curriculum requirements Spring for the Associate of Applied Science for Business Technology degree:

• Change the course number for Special Topics from BUS 2173 to BUS 2993 The course may be taken for credit two times.

Beginning with Summer I 2009 semester, in the curriculum offerings in Business Technology:

• Create AST ###1-6 Special Topics with semester credit hours varying from 1 to 6 hours of credit. The course may be taken for credit two times.

Business Technology - Banking

Beginning with Summer I 2009, in the curriculum requirements Spring for the Associate of Applied Science for Business Technology - Banking degree:

• Reflect the change of course number for Special Topics from BUS 2173 to BUS 2991-6 and allow varying hours. The course may be taken for credit two times.

Computer Information Systems

Beginning with Summer I 2009 semester, in the curriculum offerings in Computer Information Systems:

• Create CIS ###1-6 Special Topics with semester credit hours varying from 1 to 6 hours of credit. The course may be taken for credit two times.

Collision Repair Technology

Beginning with Summer I 2009 semester, in the curriculum offerings in Collision Repair Technology:

• Create CRT ###1-6 Special Topics with semester credit hours varying from 1 to 6 hours of credit. The course may be taken for credit two times.

Industrial Control Systems

Beginning with Summer I 2009 semester, in the curriculum offerings in Industrial Control Systems:

• Create ICS ###1-6 Special Topics with semester credit hours varying from 1 to 6 hours of credit. The course may be taken for credit two times.

Paramedic/Emergency Medical Services

Beginning with the Summer I 2009 semester, require a grade of "C" or better to earn the Certificate of Proficiency for EMTP 1007 Basic Emergency Medical Services and EMTP 1107 Intermediate Emergency Medical Services.

Welding Technology

Beginning with Summer I 2009 semester, in the curriculum offerings in Welding Technology:

• Create WLD ###1-6 Special Topics with semester credit hours varying from 1 to 6 hours of credit. The course may be taken for credit two times.
