Law Enforcement

- Change the course number for Emergency Medical Operations from EMTP 2212 to EMTP 2213 and increase the credit hours to 3
- Require HIT 1113 Medical Terminology
- Require HIT 1123 Human Anatomical Structure I
- Require HIT 1243 Human Anatomical Structure II

Practical Nursing

Effective with the Summer I 2015 semester:

Pending approval by the Arkansas Tech University Board of Trustees and the Department of Higher Education, change the name of the Certificate of Proficiency in Certified Nursing Assistant to Nursing Assistant.
