Cardiovascular Technology

Effective with the Fall 2016 semester: In the curriculum requirements for the AAS in Cardiovascular Technology:

- Remove the requirement for CVT 2113 Hospital Policies and Patient Care
- Reactivate and require CVT 2112 Hospital Policies and Patient Care
- Remove the requirement for CVT 2311 Interdisciplinary Cardiac Imaging
- Reactivate and require CVT 2312 Interdisciplinary Cardiac Imaging

Motion by Debbie McClure, second by Josh Freeman to approve the changes requested by Cardiovascular Technology. Motion carried.

General Technology

ATU-Ozark Campus would like to reconfigure the AAS in General Technology with eight different areas of concentration in Air Conditioning and Refrigeration, Applied Laboratory Technology, Automotive Service Technology, Computer Information systems, Collision Repair Technology, Cosmetic Science, Law Enforcement, and Welding Technology.

We will remove Air Conditioning and Refrigeration, Automotive Service Technology, and Welding Technology to create three new separate AAS degrees in each of those areas and delete the options of Air Condition and Refrigeration, Automotive Service Technology, and Welding Technology from the AAS in General Technology.

These changes would be effective with the Fall 2016 term pending Board of Trustees and Arkansas Department of Higher Education approval. Since no curriculum changes are involved, students will seamlessly transition immediately into the new degrees and majors.
