## **Logistics Management**

  - LGM 1013 Principles of Logistics and Supply Chain Management
  - LGM 2023 Transportation Management
  - LGM 2033 Warehousing and Inventory Management

As approved at our 10-12-16 meeting, we are moving Computer Information Systems and Law Enforcement out from under the General Technology Associate Degree umbrella and making them their own degrees. Applied Laboratory, Collision Repair Technology, and Cosmetic Science still remain as options in the AAS-General Technology. This change will be effective Summer 2017.
