### CALL TO ORDER

**MINUTES:** The minutes from the June, 2, 2017 Senate meeting were distributed. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Senator Bogue, seconded by Senator Schmalz, and all approved, motion carried.

### NEW BUSINESS

- **Report from President's Communication Committee:** President Spicer was unable to attend the Committee meeting therefore no report was given.
- **Report from Russellville Staff Senate** Secretary Thomas provided a report based on her notes from Russellville Staff Senate meeting which occurred July 5, 2017 on the following topics:
  - Angela Black with the Green and Gold Cupboard announced a staff competition to be starting very soon to stock the cupboard. High protein foods and hygiene products will earn the most points. The Green and Gold Cupboard is a food pantry for the entire Arkansas Tech Community including students, faculty, and staff from all campuses which hopes to have its grand opening September 2017.

- **Employee of the Month:** Tanner Howell was drawn as the August Employee of the Month.
- **Staff Senate Election of Officers:** The elections of officers took place with an open ballot with the following nominations and results:
  - Secretary nominations were opened to the floor. One nomination was made by Senator Spicer for Senator Jennifer Thomas. No other nominations were made. All approved Jennifer Thomas as secretary for a one year term.

- Vice President nominations were opened to the floor. One nomination was made by Senator Bogue nominating Senator Peter Clifton. No other nominations were made. All approved Senator Clifton as Vice President for a one year term.
- President nominations were opened to the floor. One nomination was made by Senator Bogue nominating Senator David Spicer. No other nominations were made. All approved Senator Spicer as President for a one year term.
- **Senator Bogue- E-mentoring Program:** Senator Bogue reported on a new e-mentoring program introduction for the Fall 2017 Term. Senator Bogue explained the E-mentoring program would expand the range of the current face to face mentoring program for the Ozark Campus. E-mentoring communication will take place via phone, text, email, skype, and/or social media. The e-mentoring program will be a great advantage for the students and staff who have busy schedules and cannot schedule face to face meetings.

Senator Schmalz announced she had contacts with some military personnel and volunteered to contact them. Senator Schmalz will report back to the senate as she gets information.
- **Staff Potlucks-** The senate agreed to go to Mr. Sikes for approval of the proposed quarterly staff breakfast potlucks with a brief meeting.
