An Evolving Relationship

Starting college is a time of transition for everyone in the family. Many members of the family can experience a wide range of emotions from excitement to sadness, including the student. As college educators and student services professionals, we realize this and we are here to help with this transition.

If your loved one is coming to college for the first time, here are some things you may want to do to help ease the transition:

- Be prepared. Spend time talking with your student about the transition. Be honest about your feelings, positive and negative. Let them know this is a change for BOTH of you and that you are in it together. Create communication guidelines early. Agree ahead of time on levels and types of communication you both feel good about.
- Talk to other parents and friends to create a support network. Others who have experienced this change may help with this transition.

 Advice, good ideas, encouragement and support are all valuable to you as a family member of a new college student. Seek it out and benefit from it.



- Know the resources. Stay connected with the university through email, newsletter subscriptions, and the Parent Association. If you do not know about these resources, contact the Office of Student Success at 479-968-0309
- Let go gently, but be available when needed (they will need you). Just like kindergarten, they are scared too, but excited. Be supportive and available, but also be happy for them and watch them GROW and DEVELOP!
- Take care of yourselves. Expect to feel many different emotions (this is a life changing transition for you also!) and know that this

is a normal time of change. Keep in mind, however, that no one experiences it the same way and that is ok. Congratulate yourselves for getting them (and YOU) this far!

Checklist for Your Student

- Begin checking your OneTech account daily for important emails and announcements.
- ☐ Provide any remaining admission documents to: Tech Admissions Office, Doc Bryan Student Services Center. Suite 141.
 - Final high school transcripts or transcripts from other universities
 - Immunization records (MMR2) required
 - A/P or CLEP scores
- ☐ Finalize tuition and fee payment.
 - Invoices for Fall 2012 will be mailed mid-July and are also accessible on One Tech.
 - Full tuition and fees due by August 15th, 2012.
 - On-campus students must pay at least onefourth of room and board charges, plus P.O. Box rental fee.
- ☐ Pick up Student ID card in the Student Accounts Office, Doc Bryan Student Services Center, Suite 133, beginning August 1st.
- Obtain parking hangtag at the Public Safety
 Office beginning August 1st. Parking hangtags are
 mandatory; tickets will be issued to vehicles without
 properly displayed hangtag.
- Purchase or rent books for the fall semester
 - Tech Bookstore, located in the Young Building. Buy or rent at http://www.atu.edu/bookstore/. Be sure to check out the Tech Bookstore "Tax Free Weekend Ad."

- ☐ Move in for on-campus students.
 - Freshmen may move in beginning Saturday, August 18th
 - 7 am: Nutt Hall ONLY (all floors)
 - 8:30 am: Floors ONE, THREE or FIVE of other residence halls
 - 10 am: Floors TWO and FOUR of other residence halls
 - All **returning** students may move in beginning at 9 am on Monday, August 20th.
- ☐ Attend all "GO BOLD WELCOME WEEK" activities. Students who become engaged in campus life early have a much better chance of collegiate success.
- ☐ Check schedule on OneTech August 21st for any last-minute room or course changes.
- ☐ Attend Classes beginning Wednesday, August 22nd. To be successful, attendance is essential.

Campus Hangtags How-To's

- Go to Student Accounts and get your Tech Student ID beginning August 1st.
- Go to the Tech Department of Public Safety located at 1508 North Boulder Ave, east of the Tomlinson and the Tech Bookstore.
- Present your ID at the front counter and know your housing assignment; on-campus & hall or off-campus.
- Receive your hangtag and hang it from your rear view mirror (colored side facing the front of your vehicle)

NOTE: You will get a ticket for not having a hang tag, they are mandatory.
