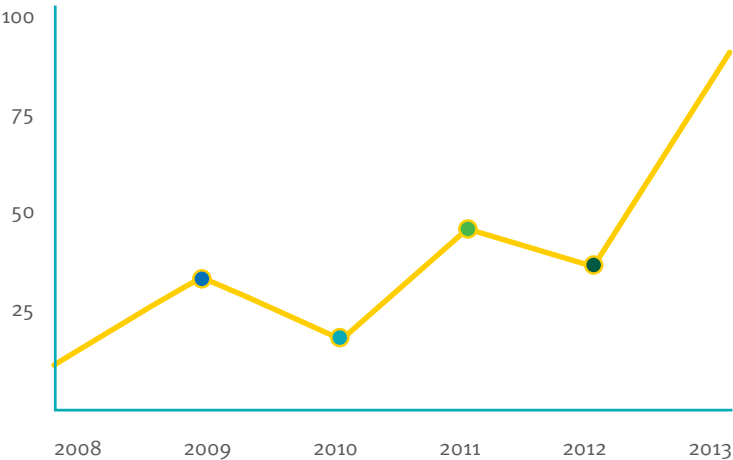
20 Years to Now

Over the past 20 years, we have raised our admission standards. The result has not been a decrease in enrollment, but instead a dramatic increase. From 1997 to 2010, enrollment at Arkansas Tech increased by an unprecedented 131 percent.

In the fall of 2011, the university surpassed a significant milestone – 10,000 students. The next year marked the 14th consecutive year of enrollment growth, reaching an all-time high of 10,950.

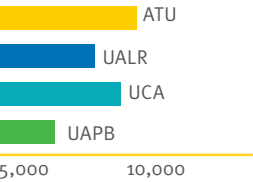

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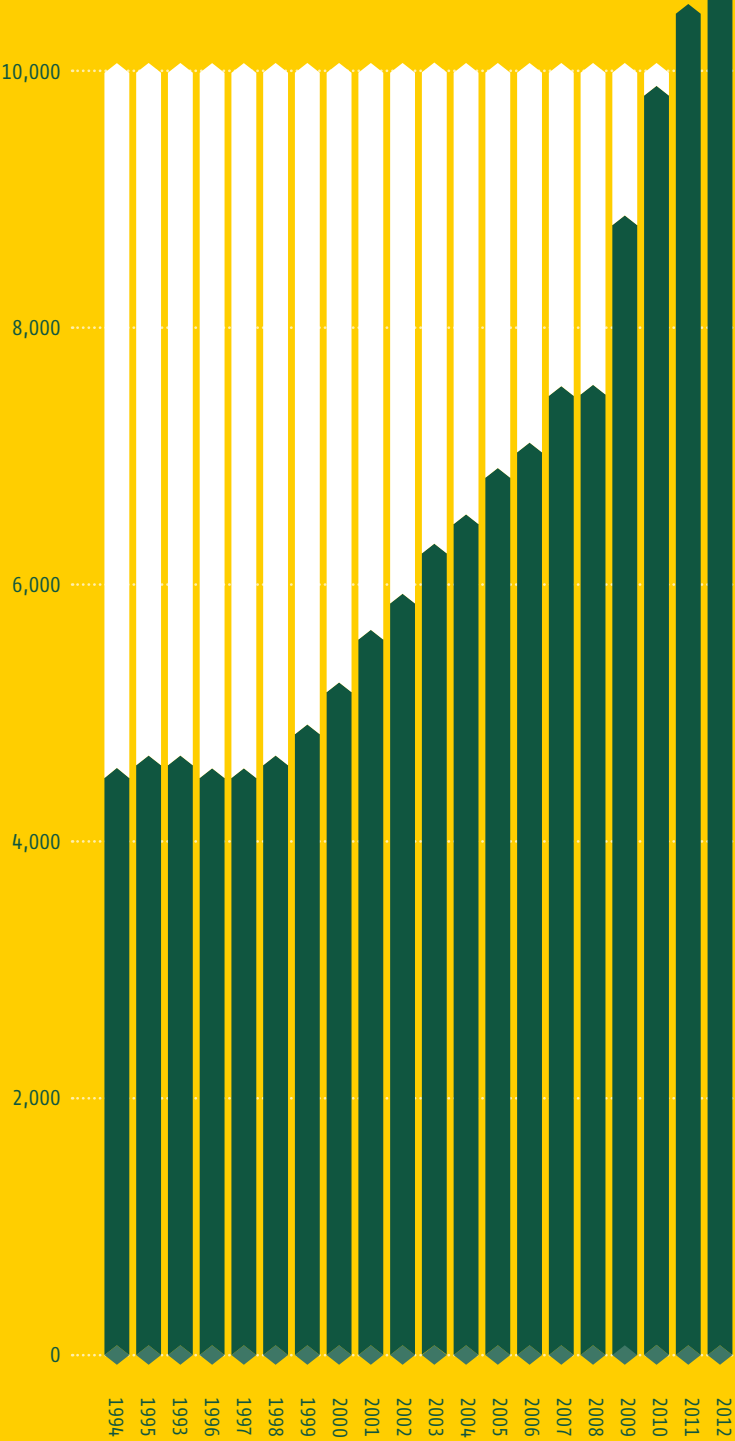
