**Final Grant Report:** Dr. Timothy Howe, Master Class and Recital Experience in Chengdu, P.R. China at the Sichuan Conservatory of Music and Beijing, P.R. China

## Synopsis of the project

Dr. Howe was to present trombone master classes and a trombone recital in Chengdu, P.R. China at the Sichuan Conservatory of Music in May, 2008 and travel to Beijing for interviews with faculty at the Beijing Central Conservatory of Music. The teaching aspect will involve 3-4 hours of master classes with Chinese trombone students for 5-6 days. The second goal for this trip was to research and write and article for the International Trombone Association Journal about trombone pedagogy and practice in P.R. China and include interviews with the Sichuan Conservatory trombone instructors and the trombone instructors at Beijing Central Conservatory of Music.

## Assessment of Objectives and Goals

We were able to successfully travel to Chengdu on May 11, 2008 and begin teaching at the Sichuan Conservatory. Unfortunately on our first day of teaching Sichuan Province experienced a catastrophic earthquake and though Chengdu experienced only minor earthquake damage, our plan and schedule for the week were altered significantly by these events. We were able to work with the students in a master class setting for 3 days in two hour master class sessions twice a day and play an informal recital during that time as arranged by the Sichuan Conservatory. I was also able to spend considerable time interviewing Mr. Sun Jing, Director of Foreign Affairs Office and former trombone professor at Sichuan Conservatory, to get material for an article about trombone in China. My contacts for an interview in Beijing were less successful because of communication problems caused by the earthquake. I was able to meet with the trombone professor at the Beijing Central Conservatory for a short time and establish a basis for further

communication in the future. In addition we were able to observe some brass lessons on the campus. Because of the incomplete nature of my meeting with the Beijing Conservatory teachers, I have not yet submitted my article to the International Trombone Association Journal pending more information. However, I am confident that I will be able to complete this task by the spring.
