THE ROOMMATE AGREEMENT

Perhaps the greatest advantage of living on campus is the opportunity to live and work closely with all types of people. The key to getting to know your roommate and getting along with them is communication. It's difficult to get to know one another without talking to each other. This document serves as a starting point for an essential conversation roommates need to have.

Each student choosing to live on campus at ATU has...

- + The right to live in a clean building and room
- + The right to expect that a roommate will respect one's personal belongings
- + The right to read and study without undue interference
- + The right to sleep without undue disturbance from noise, roommate's guests, etc.
- + The right to free access to one's room and facilities without pressure from a roommate
- + The right to personal privacy
- + The right to be free from fear or intimidation and physical or emotional harm
- + The right to have guests during visitation hours with the expectations that guests are to respect the rights of the host's/hostesses roommate or other hall residents
- + The right to expect reasonable cooperation in the use of room cable services

We believe that a structured opportunity to get acquainted and set some ground rules for your room will enhance the development of your roommate relationship and thus provide you with a more positive experience while living on campus. Use this worksheet as a guide to help you get acquainted with your roommate. Campus policies should be considered during your discussion when appropriate.
